WHAT TYPE OF FORWARDER SHOULD I CHOOSE?

There are two types of forwarders:

THE FORWARDING AGENT

When you hire a freight forwarder to manage your international shipment, you'll sign a contract of mandate. This means that the forwarder is responsible for carrying out your orders to move your goods from one place to another using various modes of transportation. However, the forwarder is not responsible for the mistakes made by other companies they may hire to help with the shipment.

THE FREIGHT FORWARDER

When you work with a freight forwarder, you can choose between two types of contracts. The first is a mandate contract, where the forwarder simply carries out your orders and takes limited responsibility. The second is a commission contract, which gives the forwarder more responsibilities and allows them to hire subcontractors. Under a commission contract, the forwarder is responsible for coordinating all the operations, choosing service providers, and negotiating with them. They are also responsible for any mistakes made by the providers they hire.

Depending on the contract, the forwarder can handle some or all of the sea transport operations, including pre-carriage to the port, storage, customs clearance, handling, embarkation, transport, disembarkation, handling, customs clearance, and deliveries.
